CERA Purpose

The Center for ELSI Resources and Analysis will:

1. Provide an established platform to share ELSI research tools and products;
2. Curate and synthesize research, highlight new findings and provide access to ELSI products
3. Convene ELSI researchers for transdisciplinary projects to facilitate synergy and integration within ELSI community

1- Resource Sharing and Coordination

- Collect, index, store, and make available ELSI research instruments and methods
- Maintain a central database of ELSI scholarship and products
- Identify research tools and products for inclusion
- Collect and coordinate information on how to access data from NHGRI-funded ELSI studies

CERA Portal

- Public online portal to facilitate sharing of ELSI resources
- Intuitive interface which allows researchers to easily contribute, navigate and locate Center resources
- Usability testing to assess ongoing needs of actual and potential users
- All resources and tools non-proprietary and open source
- All resources and tools portable and easily transferred

2- Data Integration, Synthesis and Translation

- Summarize ELSI scholarship via meta-analysis and literature review
- Identify areas of consensus, disagreement, and research gaps
- Conduct or organize methods assessments to improve rigor and reproducibility

3- Meeting Organization and Coordination

- Organize webinars, workshops or meetings generating scholarship
- Facilitate ELSI scholars' responses to current and emerging issues
- Collaborate with NHGRI and the grantee(s) organizing the biennial ELSI Congress Meeting (funded separately through a U13 mechanism)

Outreach and Engagement Plan

- Encourage and incentivize participation in the Center
- Connect ELSI researchers
- Ensure genomic researchers, practitioners, trainees, funders, and policy makers are aware of relevant NHGRI-funded work
- Inform the ELSI community about the expanding genomic landscape

Relationship to Ongoing Activities

- Central source of ELSI research tools and products from investigator-initiated awards, CEERs and consortia
- Increase the availability and visibility of ELSI resources
- **Would not replace existing Coordinating Centers, but would provide a central ELSI resource**

FAQs: Eligibility

- Multi-PI applications? – **Yes**
- Multi-site applications? – **Yes**
- Limited to CEERs? – **No**
- Foreign institution applications?
 - Applications from foreign institutions are not allowed
 - Applications with foreign components are allowed

FAQs: CERA and ELSI Congress U13

- Required to apply for CERA RFA and U13 for ELSI Congress?
 - Not required to apply for both funding opportunities.
 - Encouraged to apply for both
 - Recipients of CERA and U13 will work closely

FAQs: Data storage and access

- Will CERA store / provide access to primary data?
 - **No. Data curation and storage will not be part of CERA's mission**
 - CERA will direct portal users to other data repositories and to ELSI researchers who are sharing their data outside of the Center, e.g. through existing repositories and resources.

FAQs: CERA Purpose

- Will CERA validate or recommend specific tools and measures?
 - **No.** CERA will collect, index, store, and make publicly available data collection instruments, data dictionaries, and study methods from NHGRI-funded ELSI research.
