


AFRICAN-AMERICANS NEEDED









African-Americans 21-65 years old are invited to participate in a study entitled the GENE-FORECASTSM: <u>GEN</u>omics, <u>E</u>nvironmental <u>FactOR</u>s and the Social <u>DE</u>terminants of <u>C</u>ardiovascular Disease in <u>A</u>frican-Americans <u>ST</u>udy. This study will determine how heart disease risk factors, such as social, environmental, and genetics impact African-Americans. The study will assess healthy volunteers and those at risk for heart attack or stroke.

- A visit to the NIH Clinical Center for heart health assessments
- There is no charge for study-related assessments

You will not be able to participate if:

- You are pregnant or breast feeding
- You were not born in the United States
