- How to disseminate genomic education
- Cancer genomic testing gaps
- Networking/discussion groups, in addition to working groups, on specific topics like LMSs, cancer, GC penetrance, etc.
- Awareness campaign of genomic resources
- Standards/guidelines for lay language to use in genomic reports to enhance general understanding. It would be ideal if germline, cancer, DTC, etc. used the same language.

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- Development of specialty specific champions to help carry the content back to these specialties.
Development of in-field leaders.
- Help to consolidate resources for a particular target audience, e.g. PCP's--- there are so many places to go learn about clinical genomics, how do they know the most reputable place to go? E.g. ASHG vs. ACMG for clinical cases. It can be overwhelming to non-geneticist to know what the best resource is.
- Develop an “Academy of Genetic Educators” to foster excellence in genetics education, a roster of genetics educators with experience and excellence.



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
