Dr. Joanne Curran is a Professor in the Division of Human Genetics and the South Texas Diabetes and Obesity Institute of the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley School of Medicine. Dr. Curran received her Ph.D. in 2001 from Griffith University Gold Coast in Australia. After serving as the director of high throughput genotyping for the International Diabetes Institute in Australia, she moved to the US in 2005 to take a position at the Texas Biomedical Research Institute. She became a faculty member at UTRGV in 2015. A pioneer in the field of lipidomics, Dr. Curran has over 240 publications. Her research is focused on diseases that are health disparities in the Mexican American population, including diabetes and cardiovascular disease.
